Key Club is a service organization for high school students. The Kiwanis Club of Oakmont sponsors the Montgomery High School Key Club. Tricia Shindledecker is the Montgomery High School Key Club Kiwanis Advisor, and Ted Seche is the Faculty Advisor. **Members** of the club are invited to participate in the assembly of floats for the annual Rose Bowl Parade in Southern California. More information about this trip is below.

Transportation will be provided from Santa Rosa to the Southern California site (Irwindale, CA). Students will be constructing floats according to the design determined in advance, using glue and flowers, leaves, etc, in a cool/cold warehouse. The work is detailed and can be dirty. Students should dress in layers.

- **TIME:** tent Thursday, December 28, 2017, 7:30 am returning Saturday, December 30, 2017 at 11:00 pm.
- **Location:** Float decorating address is 5400 North Irwindale Avenue, Irwindale, CA.
- **Transportation:** Students should meet at Coddington Mall on Thursday, Decmeber 28, 2017 at 7:30 am. All students will travel together in one vehicle to Southern California. The group will be together while working, eating, sleeping, and driving. We plan to return approximately 11:00 pm on December 30, also to Coddington Mall.
- **Details:** While undoubtedly this will be a fun trip, the purpose of the trip is to help with construction of floats for the Rose Parade (aired on TV live on New Year’s Day). A maximum of 7 students will be able to participate (max. space in vehicle). Students must pack light or there will not be sufficient space. This is a “no frills”, service trip.
- **Cost:** Currently, the only cost is a per student contribution of \$20 toward travel expenses. We are working on finding a Kiwanis host family to house the group. If we cannot secure “free” housing, the maximum cost will be \$40 per student (to also cover hotel rooms). [Funds raised by selling candy may be used to cover these expenses.] Most meals are provided during float construction. Students should bring money for breakfasts, meals on travel days, and spending money.
- **First-Come, First-Reserved:** Because space is limited, the first students to return the permission form and pay the \$20 cost will be confirmed to attend. If you realize later that you cannot attend, please tell advisor Tricia Shindledecker immediately.
